

## OASIS C2—Traversing the Abyss

### A 3-Part Webinar Series

This series of three webinars will help you bridge the gap between minimum competency to optimal understanding. The series provides home health clinicians with the latest guidance on the OASIS-C2 data set, focusing on key items used for payment calculation, Home Health Quality of Care Star rating, Value Based Purchasing measures, risk adjustment, and other items that frequently present problems with accuracy. Guidance on individual items will be explained, with tips on assessment techniques to enhance selection of the correct responses.

**The Presenters will discuss:**

**Part 1:** Conventions with special attention to the change in the one clinician rule and its impact on answering process measure items and collaboration on other items, including ADLs

**Part 2:** Wound items with special attention to pressure ulcer items and surgical wounds and the coding of each

**Part 3:** Medication reconciliation and mental/behavioral items

This webinar series is geared for the field staff nurse or therapist, whether they have established the basics, or not, and offers practical application of OASIS guidance. It will also benefit OASIS reviewers and educators. It is not designed to be a preparation for the COS-C or HCS-O certification exams.
