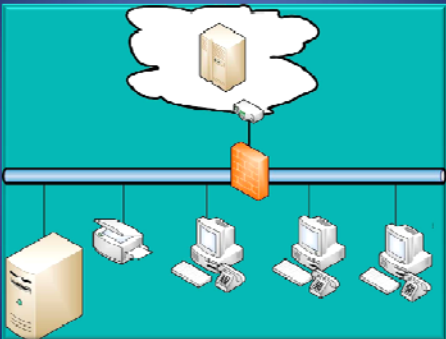

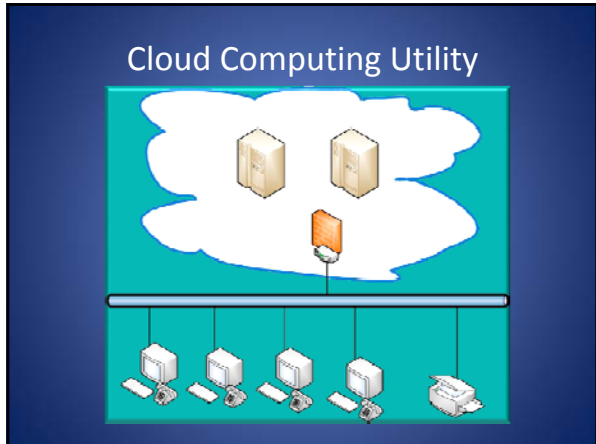

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Big Data

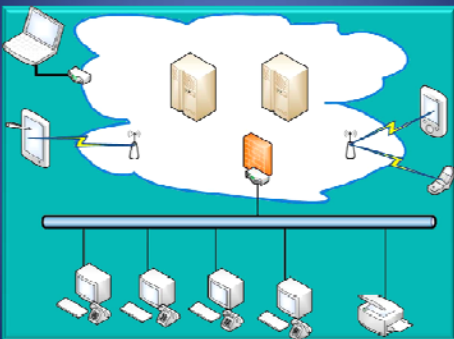
- See all data affecting the business

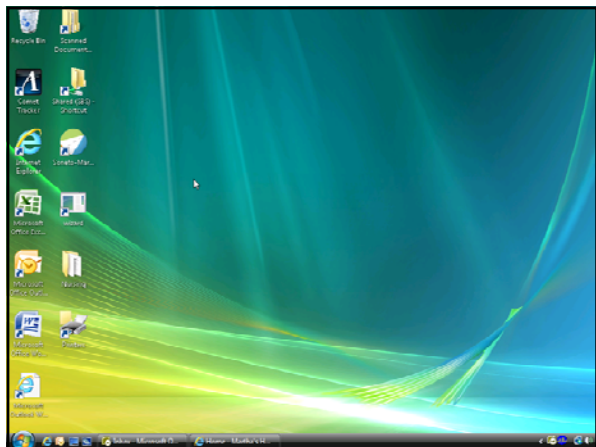

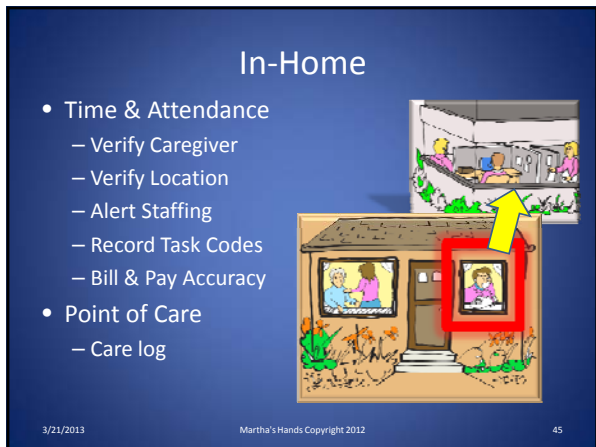
Dispatching

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Technophilia – High enthusiasm for technology



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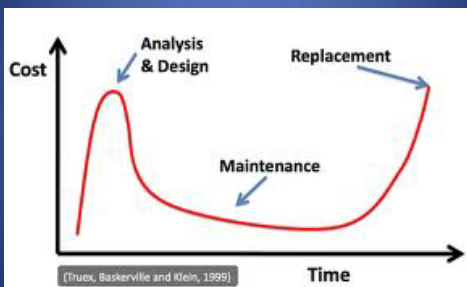
Win over the Users

- Recognize and Minimize Learning Curves
- Overcome User Resistance
- Emphasize Project Management
- Test and Train, Test and Train, Test and Train
- Carefully Plan to Deploy and Startup
- Keep a "Punchlist" of Issues to be Resolved
- Think out of the box

Benefits (what good is it?)

- Staff is more proficient
- Staff responds faster to urgent matters
- Improves health information protection
- Enables "Business Intelligence"
- Paperless Reduces Office Footprint

More Benefits (what good is it?)

- Adopting the “The Cloud” is easier on the pocketbook
