How the "IMPACT Act" Affects Home Health

January 17, 2018—The IMPACT Act of 2014 was the driving force behind the OASIS-C2 revision. For the first time, Home Health must collect/report data for quality measures that are standardized for other post-acute care (PAC) settings.
