

Coding Update FY 2020

More than 324 code changes take effect for FY 2020 along with 273 new codes, 21 code deletions and 30 code title revisions and hundreds of changes in the tabular list for coding instructions. This webinar goes beyond providing your staff with the code changes for October 1st and combines the impact of the updated coding guidelines. Any updated codes impacting PDGM, effective January 1, 2020, will also be reviewed. Class is suitable for home health & hospice. - Identify the coding changes that affect home health and hospice
- Determine which codes now require greater specificity & updated coding instructions. Highlights include to learn about the NEW deep tissue injury code; understand the additions to Chapter 9 (Diseases of the Circulatory System including additional codes added for Afib, phlebitis, embolism, and thrombosis); review the revisions to Chapter 19 (injury, poisoning and certain other consequences of external causes in the areas of poisoning adverse effects and underdosing); review updates and changes to coding guidelines effective October 1, 2019; and discuss test your knowledge cases to illustrate the new coding changes.
