## Budget Preparation Tool For MAHC Membership Dues July 1, 2019—June 30, 2020

Membership dues are based on the combination of Sites and Programs.

<u>Sites:</u> A "site" is a physical location of your company. All sites are considered members.

**<u>Programs</u>**: If you provide more than one program, you are considered a multiple program member.

Examples of Programs include: Home Health, Hospice, In-Home Services/DSDS, Consumer-Directed Services/DSDS, Private Duty/Private Pay, etc.

## How to Determine Your Dues Amount

<u>Calculation of Dues</u>: Determine the Net Operating Revenue for the ALL programs and sites. "Net Operating Revenue" includes the most recent full fiscal year's revenues, excluding disallowances, contractual adjustments and non-operating revenues such as gifts, bequests, and donations.

Then calculate your Net Operating Revenue for All Programs and Sites.

Find your dues category in the chart below. This will be the amount you will pay when you renew in July of 2018.
